This site adds on to the narrow strip of roadside trees to create a valuable “habitat node”.



It will become a safe refuge in a part of the district that is otherwise just narrow strips.





This planting adds extra width and density to the existing roadside habitat.



Planting a diverse shrub layer gives safe shelter and also more food for our rare wildlife.
